My name is Madeline Helpling, and I was just an average eighteen year old girl before my journey began. I just graduated high school where I was involved in advanced classes, three sports, and volunteer organizations.

When I look back on how this all started. I can't believe all of the signs that I missed that could have warned me to go to the doctor sooner. The swollen lymph nodes, the constant low grade fever, the back pain, and the night sweats. To me, it was "nothing" of course. (Having a mom that is a nurse really helps you believe that nothing is ever wrong with you). All I can say is. I'm so blessed to have sneezed (yes, sneezed) that day and broke my rib when I did.

After a trip to the ER, we were told before my xray that it was probably just a pulled muscle from lifting weights. After the xray came back, however, we knew that this wasn't anything close to that. The radiologist noticed a small spot near the rib that was abnormal and looked like a tumor. After a cat sean, we were ordered to have a needle biopsy performed. After the biopsy was performed and the pathologist was unable to diagnose me, we then were sent to Indianapolis to have a rib resection.

Going into surgery. I was expected to only have the small tumor and piece of rib removed. The outcome, however, wound up leaving me without large parts of two ribs, the tumor, and all of the tissue surrounding it. Deep down, after being left with a sear four times the size that was supposed to be left on my body. I knew that this was much more serious than we thought. The outcome. Osteosarcomai a rare Bone Cancer that is going to require seven long, rigorous months of chemotherapy that prevents me from moving out of my house and into my apartment with three lovely roommates and attending IUPUI to start studying to be a nurse practitioner. I was also forced to give up my job at Community Hospital in Indy where I was being trained to be a Patient Support Partner and was to gain experience by doing direct patient eare.

If you were to ask me how I am doing with all of this. I could honestly tell you that I am fine. My emotions include anger, confusion, and optimism. I'm angry, why me, why now, why can't I just be normal like my friends, who are going off to college? But at the same time, my optimism tells me that this will only make me stronger and will make me a better nurse practitioner someday.

Although I can't go to school for a year. I plan to take some online classes to keep myself busy during the down time that I will have between treatments.

I have been raised to fight for what I want and to never let anything bring me down. Thus far, this is only a bump in the long, successful road ahead of me and I will continue to fight hard and stay strong, not only for me, but for my family and the rest of my supporters.

Thank you to everyone who is following my journey and helping in any way that they can. I am not only blessed, but humbled as well at the amount of support that I have to help me along the way. Thank you so much.
