WHILE THIS SCHOOL YEAR WAS NOT WITHOUT ITS CONSTANT STRUGGLES, IT BECAME ONE OF THE MOST MEMORABLE FOR ME, NOT BECAUSE OF THE PANDEMIC, BUT BECAUSE OF THE WAY WE ALL RALLIED AND WORKED TOGETHER TO OVERCOME THE CHALLENGES WE FACED. I COULD NOT BE MORE PROUD AND THANKFUL TO BE AN ELWOOD PANTHER.



OUR FEARLESS LEADER



AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, ELWOOD HIGH SCHOOL ACQUIRED A NEW PRINCIPAL. DR. TROY FRIEDERSDORF HAS SERVED IN SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION FOR OVER 27 YEARS AND HAS VISITED MANY DIFFERENT SCHOOLS. WE ASKED DR.TROY WHAT HAVE YOU NOTICED ABOUT ELWOOD THAT SETS IT APART FROM OTHER SCHOOLS THAT YOU HAVE BEEN AT, DR.TROY SAID "THERE IS A SENSE OF COMMUNITY UNIQUE TO LIVING IN ELWOOD THAT PULLS PEOPLE TOGETHER. I BELIEVE THERE IS A CERTAIN TOUGHNESS THAT WILL ALLOW ELWOOD STUDENTS TO BOUNCE BACK STRONGER THAN EVER AFTER THE PANDEMIC." DR. TROY'S FIRST YEAR AS A PANTHER HAS BEEN DIFFERENT DUE TO THE RECENT PANDEMIC. WHEN ASKED HOW HIS FIRST YEAR AS A PANTHER HAS BEEN, DR. TROY RESPONDED WITH, "MEMORABLE AND MOSTLY ENJOYABLE. DOES NOT FEEL LIKE MY FIRST YEAR ANYMORE."

THE CONNECTION WITH FACULTY AND STUDENTS THAT DR. TROY HAS BEEN ABLE TO MAKE HAS BEEN DIFFERENT THIS YEAR DUE TO THE PANDEMIC. WHEN ASKED HOW HE HAS BEEN ABLE TO EFFECTIVELY CONNECT WITH THE STUDENTS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR, DR. TROY RESPONDED WITH "I HAVE CONNECTED THROUGH CONVERSATIONS AND EMAILS, BUT NOT AS MUCH AS I WOULD LIKE TO BECAUSE THERE ARE A LOT OF E-LEARNERS WHO I HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO MEET IN PERSON. DR. TROY HAS TRIED HIS BEST EACH AND EVERY DAY TO CONNECT WITH STUDENTS AND FACULTY. WHEN ASKED ABOUT HIS MOST MEMORABLE MOMENT WITH STUDENTS, DR. TROY RESPONDED WITH "DAMON CORNWELL GETTING A TAKEDOWN ON ME IN THE HALLWAY." THIS IS JUST ONE EXAMPLE OF THE MANY RELATIONSHIPS DR. TROY HAS BUILT DURING HIS FIRST YEAR AS THE SCHOOL'S NEW PRINCIPAL.

THE PANDEMIC DID NOT STOP DR.TROY FROM ACHIEVING GOALS HE HAD SET AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, SUCH AS: "DEVELOP GOOD RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE STAFF, STUDENTS, AND FAMILIES. ESTABLISH GOOD LINES OF COMMUNICATION. HELP STUDENTS AND STAFF HAVE A GREAT SCHOOL YEAR. IDENTIFY AREAS WHERE WE CAN IMPROVE AS A SCHOOL." WE ASKED DR.TROY HOW THE PANDEMIC HAD AFFECTED THE COMPLETION OF THE GOALS HE HAD SET OUT TO ACCOMPLISH, DR.TROY SAID "THERE WILL ALWAYS BE OBSTACLES IN LIFE THAT CAUSE US TO WORK A LITTLE HARDER AND MAYBE GET A LITTLE CREATIVE IN OUR EFFORTS TO OBTAIN OUR GOALS. THE PANDEMIC DID NOT ALTER MY GOALS, BUT IT WAS DEFINITELY A MAJOR OBSTACLE TO WORK AROUND."

DUE TO THE PANDEMIC, ELWOOD HAS HAD TO ADAPT TO NEW CHANGES AROUND THE SCHOOL, ONE MAJOR CHANGE BEING E-LEARNING DAYS ON WEDNESDAYS. WHEN ASKED IF HE BELIEVED THAT E-LEARNING WEDNESDAYS WERE BENEFICIAL, DR. TROY RESPONDED WITH "I THINK THEY HAVE BEEN VERY BENEFICIAL WITH HELPING US NAVIGATE OUR WAY THROUGH THE PANDEMIC. THEY HAVE ALLOWED OUR TEACHERS AND STUDENTS MUCH NEEDED TIME TO MANAGE THEIR WORK LOADS WHILE WORKING THROUGH UNPREDICTABLE QUARANTINES." WITH EVERYTHING STARTING TO GO BACK TO NORMAL WE ASKED DR.TROY WHAT CHANGES ARE YOU HOPING TO SEE AT THE BEGINNING OF NEXT SCHOOL YEAR, DR.TROY SAID "FOR US TO RETURN TO NORMAL ACTIVITIES AND FOR ALL OF OUR E-LEARNERS TO RETURN TO SCHOOL"

WITH THE RECENT PANDEMIC, NURSE BOCK HAS HAD TO WORK HARDER THAN EVER TO KEEP THE STUDENTS AND STAFF SAFE. NURSE BOCK HAS WORKED TIRELESSLY ALL YEAR TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-IP THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL. WE ASKED NURSE BOCK DO YOU HAVE ANY SPECIFIC REASONS AS TO WHY YOU BECAME A NURSE? THE PANDEMIC DIDN'T STOP MRS. BOCK FROM ACHIEVING HER GOALS THIS YEAR. WE ASK NURSE BOCK WHAT WERE SOME GOALS SHE WISHED TO ACCOMPLISH AT THE START OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, SHE RESPONDED BY SAYING, "A GOAL I HAD FOR THIS YEAR WAS TO PROTECT OUR STUDENTS AND STAFF FROM COVID BY EDUCATING PEOPLE ABOUT AND ADHERING TO THE GUIDELINES SET BY THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND INFECTION." THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR, MRS. BOCK WORKED DAY IN AND DAY OUT TO PROTECT THE STUDENTS AND STAFF FROM COVID-I9. WHEN ASKED HOW THE PANDEMIC HAD AFFECTED SOME OF THE GOALS SHE HAD HOPED TO ACCOMPLISH THIS SCHOOL YEAR, SHE SAID, "THE PANDEMIC CREATED NEW AND INTERESTING OBSTACLES THIS YEAR! EXTRA CLEANING EFFORTS BY OUR MAINTENANCE STAFF WAS DEFINITELY KEY TO HELPING STOP THE SPREAD WITHIN OUR SCHOOL. OUR DATA SHOWS VERY MINIMAL SPREAD OF THE VIRUS BETWEEN STUDENTS WHILE THEY WERE IN OUR BUILDINGS. I AM THANKFUL FOR EVERYONE'S COOPERATION!"

WITH EVERYTHING SLOWLY GOING BACK TO NORMAL WE ASKED NURSE BOCK WHAT CHANGES ARE YOU HOPING TO SEE AT THE BEGINNING OF NEXT SCHOOL YEAR, NURSE BOCK RESPONDED WITH "I TRULY HOPE WE WILL BE CLOSER TO A 'NORMAL' YEAR, WITHOUT HAVING TO WEAR MASKS AND WITHOUT HAVING TO QUARANTINE." CONSIDERING ALL OF THE CHALLENGING OBSTACLES DUE TO THE PANDEMIC THIS YEAR, NURSE BOCK HAS DONE A GREAT JOB OF PROTECTING US FROM COVID-19. OVERALL, OUR SCHOOL CORPORATION THANKS YOU FOR ALL OF YOUR HARD WORK AND DEDICATION TO PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 AT ELWOOD HIGH SCHOOL.

DUE TO COVID-I9, PROM WAS ON THE VERGE OF BEING CANCELED FOR THE SECOND YEAR IN A ROW. GATHERINGS OF LARGE GROUPS WERE STILL NOT RECOMMENDED, AND WITH PROM BEING A LARGE SCHOOL EVENT, THE RESTRICTIONS WERE BOUND TO BE PLENTIFUL. BUT, DUE TO A LARGE COLLABORATIVE EFFORT TO INSTALL THE BEST POSSIBLE GUIDELINES, IT WAS ABLE TO HAPPEN. WE DECIDED TO INTERVIEW SENIOR, MADISON MORGAN, ON HER OUTLOOK OF PROM THIS YEAR.

"ALTHOUGH I HAD NEVER BEEN TO A PROM BEFORE THIS, I FELT A SENSE OF NORMALITY WHILE I WAS THERE. ACADEMIC TEAM





JAYDEN AND HIS DAD

JAYDEN HAS BEEN A PART OF THE ELWOOD CROSS COUNTRY TEAM FOR TWO YEARS. LIKE ALL OTHER ATHLETES, HE HAS HAD TO DEAL WITH COMPLICATIONS ARISING FROM THE CORONAVIRUS. WE ASKED JAYDEN HOW COVID HAS AFFECTED THIS SEASON. HE REPLIED, "IT AFFECTED THE SEASON A LOT IN THE BEGINNING BECAUSE IN THE FIRST 2 MEETS, WE WERE DOWN A RUNNER SO WE COULDN'T COMPETE AS A TEAM. AND, THERE WERE 2 MEETS THAT WE COULDN'T HAVE FANS WHICH IS REALLY HARD TO RUN WITHOUT ANYONE CHEERING." OTHER THAN COMPLICATIONS WITH COVID, JAYDEN HAD TO RUN THE SEASON UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF A NEW COACH. WHEN ASKED ABOUT COACH WILLIAMS, JAYDEN SAID THAT HE COULD, "GO ON AND ON ABOUT HOW MR. WILLIAMS PUSHED THE WHOLE TEAM TO BETTER OURSELVES THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE YEAR. HE GAVE US ADVICE THAT I WOULD NEVER HAVE THOUGHT ABOUT AND INFORMATION THAT I DIDN'T EVEN KNOW WAS A THING. OVERALL IT WAS A SUCCESSFUL SEASON AS A WHOLE TEAM THANKS TO HIM."

THROUGHOUT THE SEASON JAYDEN HAD ACHIEVED QUITE A LOT FOR A SOPHOMORE. HE HAD GOTTEN FIRST PLACE AT TWO MEETS AND QUALIFIED FOR SEMI-STATE EVEN WITH A PAINFUL FOOT INJURY. THE FIRST MEET OF THE YEAR AT LAPEL JAYDEN GOT HIS FIRST NUMBER ONE SPOT IN A RACE. A FEW WEEKS LATER AT HAMILTON HEIGHTS JAYDEN GOT HIS SECOND FIRST PLACE SPOT ALONG WITH A TROPHY. WHEN ASKED ABOUT THE SUCCESS HE EXPERIENCED THIS SEASON, JAYDEN RESPONDED BY SAYING, "IT FELT GOOD BECAUSE LAST YEAR I DIDN'T WIN A SINGLE MEET." HOWEVER, A FEW PRACTICES BEFORE CIC, JAYDEN HAD A SHARP CRAMP IN HIS RIGHT FOOT WHILE RUNNING. AFTER HAVING A VERY SUCCESSFUL 2020 CROSS COUNTRY SEASON, WE ASKED JAYDEN HOW HE WILL PREPARE HIMSELF FOR NEXT YEAR. JAYDEN SAID "I'M GOING TO START TRAINING A LITTLE EARLIER THAN I DID THIS YEAR. RUNNING OVER THE SUMMER IS A BIG FACTOR." WITH SUCH AN EXTENSIVE AMOUNT OF SUCCESS COMING TO JAYDEN AS A SOPHOMORE, WE ASKED JAYDEN IF HE HAD ANY FUTURE PLANS REGARDING AN ATHLETIC CAREER? JAYDEN SAID "I HAVE AN OPEN MIND BUT I'M LEANING TOWARDS A SKILL TRADE." THANK YOU JAYDEN FOR REPRESENTING THE ELWOOD PANTHERS.

THE ELWOOD CROSS COUNTRY TEAM HAS HAD A LOT OF SUCCESS THROUGHOUT THEIR SEASON WITH THE "CHERRY ON TOP" BEING PANTHER NATION'S OWN SOPHOMORE JAYDEN REESE MAKING IT TO SEMI-STATE THIS YEAR. HOWEVER, ALL OF THIS SUCCESS CAME WITH A NEW COACH AT THE HELM. WHEN ASKED WHAT HIS FAVORITE MEMORY WAS FROM THIS SEASON, COACH WILLIAMS STATED, "I THINK PLACING THIRD AT THE MADISON COUNTY MEET WAS PROBABLY THE BEST MEMORY BECAUSE IT WAS UNEXPECTED." WE ASKED COACH WILLIAMS WHAT THE TEAM NEEDED TO IMPROVE ON IN ORDER TO CONTINUE THEIR SUCCESS, HE STATED THAT HE HAD TWO AREAS THAT HE WISHED TO SEE IMPROVEMENT IN, "THE FIRST IS WE NEED TO ATTRACT MORE RUNNERS TO BOTH TEAMS. THE SECOND IS THAT WE NEED TO RUN MORE IN THE OFF SEASON." TO THE ELWOOD HIGH SCHOOL TRACK & FIELD TEAM, THIS QUOTE MEANS MANY DIFFERENT THINGS. IT IS NOT FOCUSING ON JUST ONE TYPE OF ATHLETE OVER ANOTHER, BUT INCLUDES EVERYONE. IT COULD APPLY TO SPRINTERS, DISTANCE RUNNERS, THROWERS, AND HIGH/LONG JUMPERS. TO OUR FIRST TIME COACHES OF THE PROGRAM, GIRLS COACH, HOPE FRED, AND BOYS COACH, DEREK JOHNSTON, THE SENSE OF UNITY AMONGST THE ATHLETES IS THE KEY POINT THEY'RE TRYING TO GET ACROSS THIS SEASON. THE ENVIRONMENT OF THE TEAM HAS CHANGED TREMENDOUSLY BECAUSE OF THE NEW COACHES, AND THEY CAN'T BE THANKED ENOUGH!

AS NEW COACHES OF THE PROGRAM, THERE ARE DEFINITELY MIXED FEELINGS OF NERVOUSNESS AND CONFIDENCE. COACH JOHNSTON IS VERY EXCITED AT THE FACT THAT WE CAN EVEN RUN. SINCE LAST YEAR ALL SPRING SPORTS WERE CANCELLED DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. COACH HOPE, ON THE OTHER HAND, IS A LITTLE NERVOUS ABOUT IT BEING HER FIRST SEASON, BUT SHE IS STILL VERY EXCITED TO DIVE RIGHT INTO THE SEASON. NEITHER COACH JOHNSTON OR COACH HOPE IS FOCUSED SOLELY ON WINNING. INSTEAD, THEY BOTH WANT TO SEE IMPROVEMENT ON A PERSONAL LEVEL, AS WELL AS A TEAM. BOTH COACHES ARE TRYING TO CHANGE THE WAY THE ELWOOD TRACK & FIELD PROGRAM IS RUN. COACH HOPE'S MAIN GOAL IS TO INSTILL THE ESSENCE OF BEING A SUPPORTIVE TEAM INTO THE ATHLETES. SHE AND COACH JOHNSTON WANT EVERYONE TO BE ABLE TO FEEL SUPPORTED BY THE WHOLE TEAM, NO MATTER WHAT EVENT YOU ARE IN. COACH JOHNSTON'S MAIN GOAL IS TO CHANGE THE ATTITUDE THAT HE HAS AS A COACH, AND THE MINDSET THAT HE IS TRYING TO INSTILL INTO ALL OF THE ATHLETES. HE IS TRYING TO STICK BY THE QUOTE THAT MR. WILLIAMS GAVE HIM IN THE EARLIER CROSS COUNTRY SEASON, "DO NOT GET CAUGHT UP IN DAILY SUCCESSES OR FAILURES. HE BELIEVES THAT THIS MEANS THAT THE ATHLETES CANNOT LET ONE BAD PRACTICE OR MEET MESS EVERYTHING UP FOR WHAT CAN BE HELD FOR THEM IN THE FUTURE. HE THINKS THE ATHLETES SHOULD ONLY FOCUS ON WHAT CAN BE ACHIEVED IN THE FUTURE, INSTEAD OF WHAT HAPPENED AT THE LAST MEET OR PRACTICE. BOTH COACH HOPE AND COACH JOHNSTON WANT TO STRESS THE IMPORTANCE OF EVERY EVENT AND EVERY ATHLETE WHO PARTICIPATES IN THEM. NEITHER ONE OF THEM EVER WANT TO MAKE AN ATHLETE FEEL LIKE THEY ARE LESS IMPORTANT THAN THE REST, JUST BECAUSE THEY PARTICIPATE IN A DIFFERENT EVENT. THIS IS ONE OF THE MOST ADMIRABLE COACHING VIRTUES THAT COULD BE EXPRESSED WITHIN THIS GROWING PROGRAM.

THERE IS ALSO ONE OTHER COACH THAT IS A PART OF THE ELWOOD TRACK AND FIELD PROGRAM - JOHNNIE WILSON. JOHNNIE HAS BEEN COACHING FOR THE TEAM FOR 10 YEARS, AND WHEN ASKED HIS OPINION ON HOW HE SEES THE PROGRAM EMERGING AFTER THE NEW HEAD COACHES TOOK OVER, HE WAS VERY OPTIMISTIC AND PLEASED AT THEIR PERFORMANCE. 
