My Darling Wife,

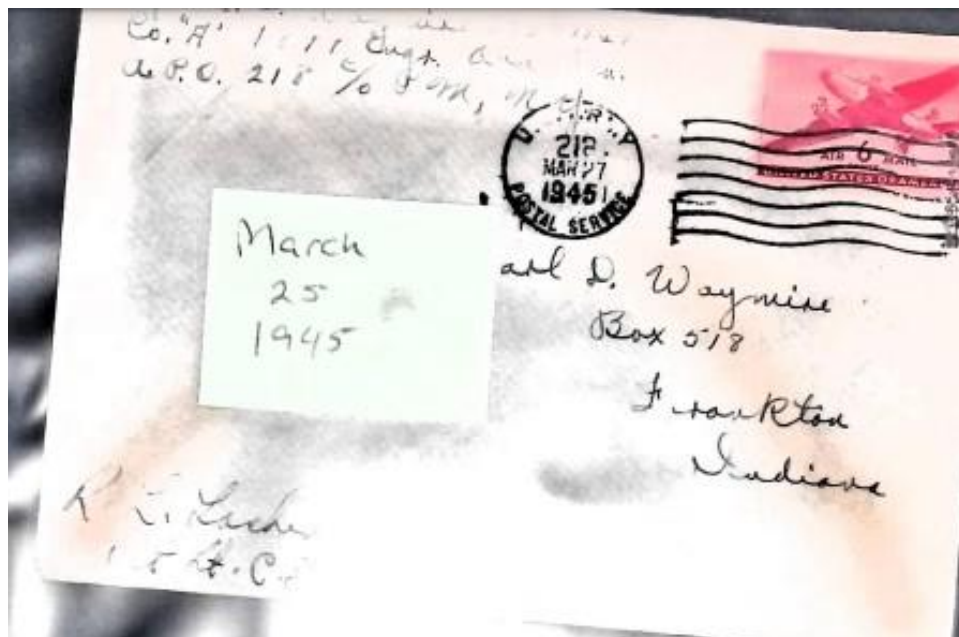
