Dearest Mary,

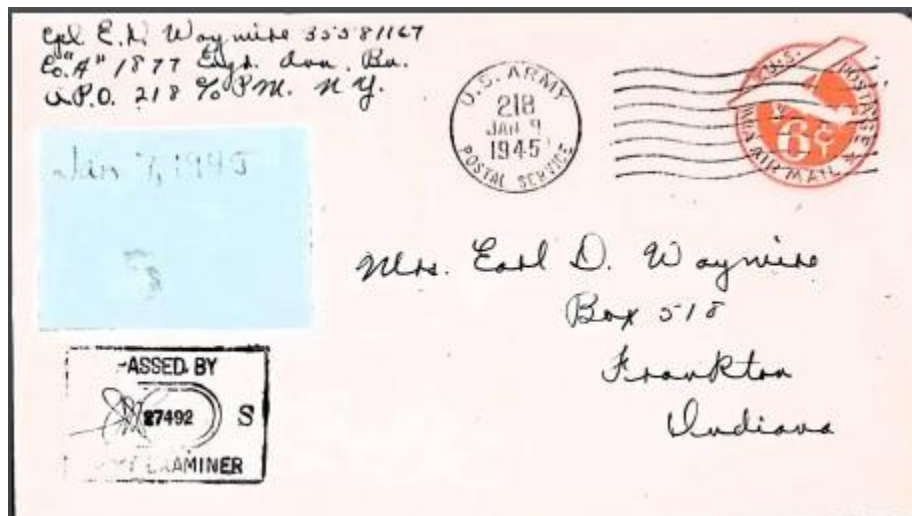
