I just came from the movie. "To Have or Have Not." H. Bogart played in it, and he played his part very good. This was the best show that I've seen for a long time.

We got our rations today. Candy, peanuts, one case of beer, cookies, cigars, cigarettes 1 ½ carton, ten packs of gum, three cans of fruit-juice, and a carton of matches. This cost twenty rupees, that's not too bad!

No mail came in today. I've been getting a lot of mail the last few days, I hope it keeps coming.

It's almost my bed time, so I will stop. I love you very much, Mary.
